Requirements for Provision of Parking Information

The purpose of collecting the Parking Information (PI) is to facilitate sharing of the
information among the public to reduce unnecessary journeys in search of vacant
parking spaces. PI on spaces that may be used by members of the public, bona fide
guests, visitors or invitees of the occupiers or patrons of the hotel (if any) for
short-term parking on hourly basis shall be supplied according to the following
requirements and any other requirements as may be specified by the Government
Chief Information Officer.

Contents, Format and Frequency

- (a) The real-time parking vacancy data should be provided to the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer at no less than one-minute interval and in JSON format as web service endpoint. The information on parking vacancy should be provided by types of spaces suitable for parking of motor cycles, private cars, light buses, light goods vehicles, medium/heavy goods vehicles, buses and whether they are provided with electric charging facilities.
- (b) The information to be provided in respect of the car park before the date as specified in paragraph 2 below, and as and when there are changes, should include, but not limited to, the following:
 - i. name;
 - ii. address:
 - iii. locations of entrance and exit of the car park;
 - iv. headroom; and
 - v. opening hours.
- 2. The supply of PI shall commence before making an application for a Certificate of Compliance for the development or four months after issuance of the first Occupation Permit, whichever is the earlier, or on such other date as may be decided and specified by the Government Chief Information Officer.
- 3. The data provider is responsible for the accuracy and reliability of the data.
- 4. The Government Chief Information Officer reserves the right to amend the above requirements for provision of PI from time to time.
