

2015 Policy Address

"The latest Digital 21 Strategy envisions that the Government will make wider use of sensors, the Internet of Things and big data analytics for better public services and sustainable social and economic growth."

".....to set up an Innovation and Technology Bureau...."

".....injecting \$5 billion into the ITF and subsuming the Research and Development Cash Rebate Scheme under the Fund."

"We intend to use Kowloon East as a pilot area to explore the feasibility of developing a Smart City."

".....free online government information will be released in digital formats to encourage development of more applications by start-ups."

Smart City Concept

A "Smart City" is often perceived as a city using digital/Information & Communications technologies (ICT) to enhance performance of the city and the wellbeing of the citizens. Yet, the concept is much wider...

> **Smart Economy** - High productivity, entrepreneurship and ability to transform

Smart Mobility - Strong ICT infrastructure and sustainable transport systems

Smart Environment - Sustainable and integrated resource management, pollution prevention and environmental protection

Smart People - Diversity, creativity and participation in public life

Smart Living - Cultural facilities, housing quality, health and safety issues

Smart Governance - Political strategies and perspectives, transparency and community participation in decision-making





Higher Greening Ratio (10% in addition to PNAP APP-152)


Notes:

- KTD: higher greening ratio already agreed by CPLD in May 2011













Building Roof and Facade Integrated Solar Panel





Building's Energy Management System




Smart Electricity Meters

- Benefits: can save energy and improve supply network efficiency
- CLP Smart-meter programme on trial basis
 - Residential (to facilitate behavioural change)
 - Commercial (with prior agreement, demand-response control in some hotel sites to cut demand during peak periods
 - → CLP receptive to extending trial to Kowloon East
- Implementation subject to CLP's proposal and Government's assessment of feasibility and tariff implication.



Smart City Total Water Management



Smart Water Meters

- Benefits: can save water and detect leakage of water pipes
- WSD Automatic Meter Reading (ARM) pilot scheme
 - selected government quarters and housing estates of Un Chau
 Estate and Cheung Lung Wai Estate
- Proposed extension of these applications to all private development sites in KE







> Data.one – Over 70 types of datasets provided by 25 data providers in 18 different categories








